

With *The Carrier*, irene grau encompasses a series of actions that she carried out in the Swiss Alps during the summer months of 2018, referencing the practice of hiking as well as the traditions of landscape painting and monochrome painting. In this project, the Spanish artist set herself the premise of creating a series of backpack paintings and using them to undertake a series of hikes in the footsteps of important Swiss landscape painters such as Caspar Wolf, Alexandre Calame, Aberli, François Diday and Ferdinand Hodler. The aim was to reconstruct the walks of these painters in the alpine mountains and to revive them. Each backpack painting, which is always based in size and color palette on a painting by one of these famous Swiss painters, was painted outdoors shortly before heading out on the hike, so that the drying process of the painting corresponds to the course of the hike. In this way, the landscape adheres to the painting on a physical level.

In addition, each painting is supplemented by notes in the form of a booklet that includes the route, elevation information, time, and photographic documentation of the hikes taken by her brother Álex Grau.

This is a large project that includes 28 oil paintings with backpack handles and 26 booklets with the documentation of the walks and its technical information. Each painting is linked to a walk and its corresponding booklet.





The **installation** works with the following premises: repetition, rhythm and interaction. As in the walk itself, a tour is proposed allowing a different reading of the painting, a way of seeing based on a more paused and fragmented perception, but also continuous and multidirectional.

To hang up the bag paintings, a sequence of equal intervals is proposed, like a sequence of steps, in which the frames will alternate. It can be studied hanging the paintings live during the opening wearing the bag paintings and carry them to the place where they will remain hanging. The installation is completed with a series of tables or/and benches, on which a series of booklets showing the history of each bag painting will be available to viewers so they can consult them freely.
